34th CHEPs Eye Camp

Muranga County

Venue: Muranga town

Date: 4th April 2015

The 34th CHEPs eye camp was held in Muranga town. Murang'a County is one of the five counties in Central region of the Republic of Kenya. It is bordered to the North by Nyeri, to the South by Kiambu, to the West by Nyandarua and to the East by Kirinyaga, Embu and Machakos counties. It lies between latitudes 0o 34' South and 107' South and Longitudes 36o East and 37o 27' East. The CHEPs team examined 153 men, women and children for eye conditions. 104 people with reading problems were provided with reading glasses. 43 people were provided with eye drops for various eye conditions mainly allergies and infections. 11 were referred for cataract surgery. The eye camp was totally sponsored by Beta Charitable Trust of UK.
